Main Objectives of the Projects:

- To provide child centric, ecofriendly method of teaching by adopting the standardized state curriculum.
- To increase economical accessibility of preschool education to the children belonging to economically poor & minority communities.
- To mainstream the targeted children into the formal primary schools after their pre-primary education is complete.
- To Assess & Evaluate the children periodically.

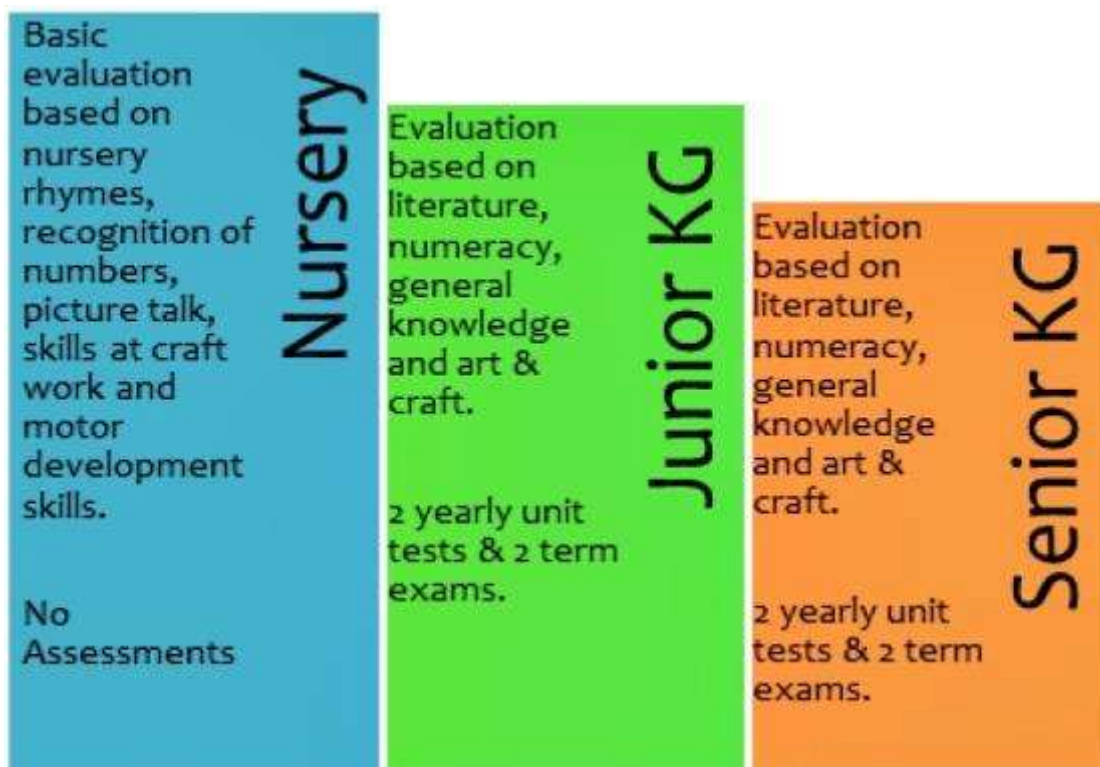
Main beneficiaries of the project:

72 children within the age-group of 2.5 - 6 years and belonging to economically backward communities are the target-groups of the proposed project. All the targeted children come from lower middle class & financial constrain families. Some children belong to single parent, some living in joint family with many dependents and only single or two bread earners. Janvi & Anavi Kindergarten School allows not only a learning environment for the students but also gives them a platform to explore, interact and grow that other student of their community struggle to be exposed to.

Pre-primary Education Program:

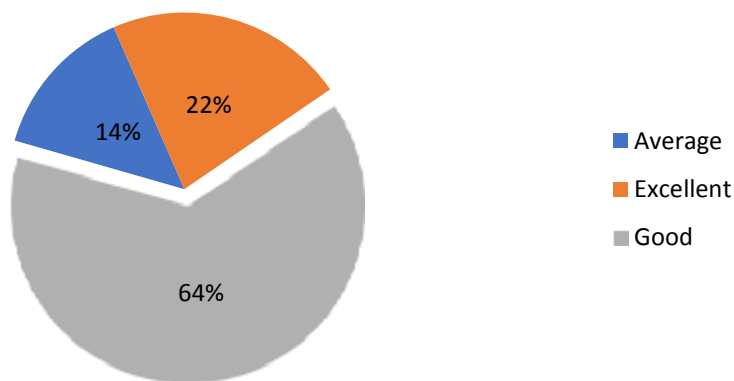
There are at present 72 children within the age group of 2.5 - 6 years. They are receiving pre-primary education in a children friendly atmosphere from 2 qualified teachers at ech center attached with this school and a support staff to take care of them. The students are regularly provided with training and learning materials though verbal, visual and hands-on method of learning. The medium of education is English. The academics at Janvi & Anavi Kindergarten School is extremely interactive, children friendly and participatory. The teachers have already developed a cordial relation with the children. The children are provided with school uniform, bags, books, stationery, art & craft materials. They have a well equipped play area for recreational activities too.

To monitor the progress of the children, children are classified according to their age groups into Play Group, Nursery, Junior KG and Senior KG.



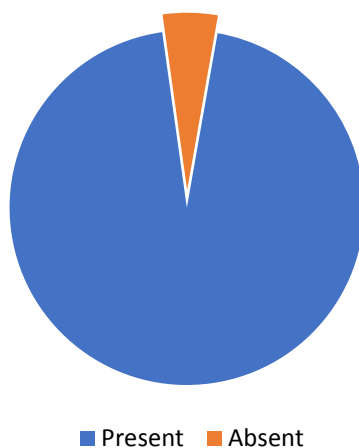
The Pie chart below represents how the students of Junior and Senior KG have fared in their academic evaluations. Where 14% of students fall into the slow learner or Average group. 22 % children are sharp minded and excellent at their task assigned and 64 % students have progressed well throughout their academic period. The same has been represented using a pie chart below.

What is also worth mentioning is the outstanding attendance of the students on a regular basis – an average of 95% attendance is recorded by the teachers for the past academic year.

Due to Covid-19 we had to shut down schools hence the closing ceremony wasn't done nor was the final assessment conducted this academic year.

Future Plan and New Academic beginning 2020-21

With the lockdown still on and no clarity on offline schooling, Janvi has now gone online and currently teaching JR. & SR. KG. through online teaching programs. Understanding the dilemma of parents and children being locked indoor, we do conduct online activities such as singing, fun based educational quiz for both students and parents. This helps us to understand the child's wellbeing through interaction module and help parents and provide counselling and guidance under the expertise by a child psychologist.

Sooner or later the schools shall begin and we want to provide a safe environment for everyone at Janvi & Anavi following the Government norms on Social distancing. We also plan to support the students and their family till the situation ease out. This year we also want to reach out to many children and families affected due to this crisis in helping them out with fee sponsorship program.

Our main focus for this academic year under Covid-19 Pandemic:

1. To maintain standard hygiene procedure for the school as per protocol set.
2. To run online till approval received for reopening of school.
3. To provide ration supply to the school parents for at least 3 months for sustainability.
4. To provide immunity boosting snacks to the children.

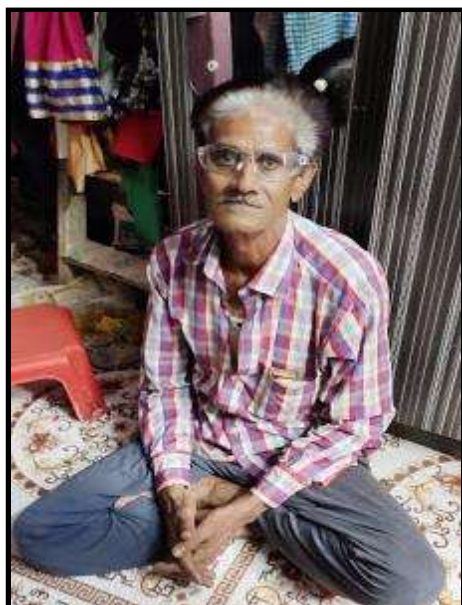

SCHOOL FEES SPONSORSHIP

Every year before the beginning and end of the school academic year, hundreds of parents throng the Community centre of Janvi Trust, located in the midst of the slum area. They come with great hope of getting their children's school fees sponsored. They are unable to pay the school fees for varied reasons. Either a sudden death, of the main bread earner, who could be the father or due to some serious medical problems with any of their family member, which drains their finances or simply because their income is too less, to afford the rising costs of education expenses. Many of these parents have migrated from their villages to Mumbai city for improving their financial status but they find it extremely difficult to meet all their expenses, especially the high rent for their shanties or a small one room house. Amidst all these difficulties they try their best to provide an English medium education to their children with high hopes that will improve and secure their future. The average annual school fees at a simple English Medium School is around Rs. 14000 - 25000 per year.

The fee payments are made directly to the schools in the names of the deserving students after doing home visits and verifying the genuine needs of their problems.



SPORTS & ENVIRONMENT

Janvi Football Team along with the support of Oscar Foundation have been into promoting the sport for the past 5 years. There are 30 children enrolled in this program.



Janvi Trust continued to maintain the two gardens it had created in the Saki Naka Pipeline slum area. Previously these two gardens were a garbage dumping ground in the slums.
